Can I enrol on all the dates, or are they separate short courses?



These are 1, 2 or 3 day courses, some run on Tuesdays, others on Thursdays. The practical work is seasonal, so if you have availability, you can register once as a WEA learner and then join all the courses. Further detail of each course is available online.

What to wear/bring:

- Much of the course will be outdoors, with shelter provided in the event of poor weather. Please bring:
- Warm clothes in winter & early spring (layers and a hat!)
- Suncream and a sun hat in late spring & summer
- Water bottle
- Waterproof jacket and trousers*
- Sturdy shoes (boots/wellies)*
- Packed lunch*



Fees & funded places: Course fees do not apply if you are in receipt of income related benefits (UC, ESA or JSA) or earning under £21,255.00 per year. For a free place you will be asked to show proof of benefits or sign a simple self declaration form.

*Further support with boots, waterproofs, travel and refreshments may be available via the farm, subject to funding.
